Nebraskan Wins Ridler Award
With PPG ENVIROBASE Paint

The 1940 Ford coupe named "Checkered Past" was built by owner Ron Cizek of Bennington, Nebraska. Cizek originally started building the car himself three-and-a-half years ago as a tribute to the vehicle's drag-racing history. After the build started, Cizek met Andy Leach, an Omaha area fabricator. Cizek was impressed enough with Leach's design talent and fabrication skills that the two of them decided to open up a shop, Cal Automotive Creations, in Omaha. Checkered Past is their first completed concept-to-finished-show-car project. The roof has been chopped and the hood and fenders re-contoured; a custom grille and hand-shaped running boards are only some of the body modifications. Once the body was finished, former Boyd Coddington painter **Charlie Hutton** sprayed the car at his Color Studio in a **PPG Envirobase** three-stage finish with red, gold and brown layers. The result is sort of a deep cranberry color. Under the hood is a supercharged fuel injected flathead Ford V-8 with a six-speed Tremec.
