Pre-Cleaners are a critical component to the painting process. Both a waterborne and solvent borne cleaner should be used to remove all contaminants from a surface. When using a pre-cleaner such as OneChoice® SX330 Wax and Grease Remover or SWX350 H2O-So-Clean® Waterborne Pre-cleaner, **DO NOT** allow the cleaner to dry on the panel. Cleaners are designed to float contaminants to the surface and then be wiped with a clean, dry cloth. If it is not completely wiped dry before painting, wipe marks may be evident in the finished film. This may lead to paint failures such as blistering and adhesion loss. Whether you use cleaner from an aerosol can or a pump applicator, always apply utilizing this "Spray on/Wipe off" procedure.

When is the last time you replaced your air hose? A leaking or cracked air hose can be robbing the spray gun of air and the ability to properly atomize material, thus causing orange peel. Rubber air hose can also start to breakdown and launch small pieces of black rubber into the finish. Worn and leaking quick-connects can cause the air compressor to run more often causing unneeded wear on the pump & higher power bills.

Regularly check air hoses for damage and replace them before problems arise.
